Remarking / Appeal	31 March	4 August	7 December	<p>Candidates who receive a fail grade have the option of applying for a post-results review of marking (remarking) for a fee of RM106 or USD50, this is non-refundable. It should be noted that a re-mark of the exam papers is NOT guaranteed in the change of final result.</p> <p>The post-result review of marking will be ready within 1 month from the remarking closing date.</p>
10.	Certificate / Transcript	Effective June 2015, Certificate of completion will be given out during Graduation Ceremony. However, completion letter and transcript will be issued to candidates at the time of completion of the respective programme.
